very year, from late August to early November, tens of thousands of events take place across Europe.

These events offer easy access to cultural sites and experiences, giving people the chance to explore and learn about their shared heritage—while encouraging them to take an active role in preserving it for future generations.

The initiative was launched in the Council of Europe in 1985, and in 1999 was joined by the European Union to create the joint action, which has continued up to the present day.
